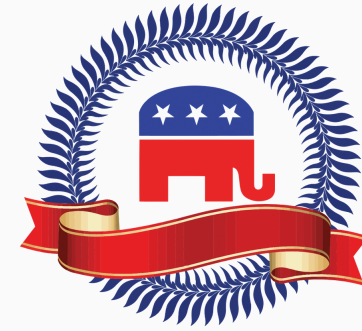

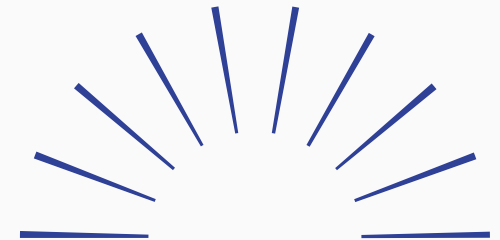

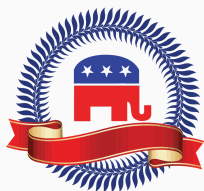
Additionally, we work to promote the Republican principles of limited government, free markets, strong families, individual freedoms, personal responsibility, and a strong national defense.

Activities

The Western Cumberland County Republican Club has had an active and exciting start. Below are a few of our activities.

The WE THE PEOPLE Speakers Series started in January 2020. The Speakers Series season runs from September to May. Each season has three meetings held in September, January, and April or May.

The Republican Leadership Academy is a new initiative to be started Spring 2021. Its purpose is to inspire, train and equip Republicans to be leaders and productive members of their communities politically and beyond.

The Annual Fall Legislative Update is held in October and allows for legislators who represent our focus area to share what is happening at their level of government.
